Annuals

Petunia – Bee's Knees

Color: Yellow

Distinction: This could be the best performing yellow petunia to date. Holds its rich yellow color, which has been a challenge for other petunias. Described by breeders and growers and one of the most exciting introductions this year.

Spacing: 18 - 24" (46 - 61cm)

Height: 8 - 10" (20 - 25cm)

Exposure: Sun



Impatiens – Beacon

Color: Various

This 2020 introduction is a game changer for walleriana impatiens. This variety is downy mildew resistant and can be grown in areas where downy mildew has invaded. It does have a competitor, Imara, which still recommends a fungicide application. Beacons do not. This impatiens won numerous awards in 2020.

Begonia – Prism Series

Color(s): Scarlet, Sunset, Rose Shades, Orange Shades, Yellow, White

Another 2020 introduction, this tuberous begonia flower sits on top of the foliage which staves off disease. 10-15% more vigor, larger blooms, along with better uniformity over the NonStop variety

Calibrachos (million bells)

There are several new varieties and colors of calibrachoa this year.

1. ChaCha Tangerine – This is a higher vigor series for not only larger size pot/hanging baskets but to give you a great option to add to combo. Large, early, uniform, premium. Cha Cha Replaces the Can Can Series

Marigold African – Marvel II

Color(s): Orange, Yellow

Marigold Marvel II has improved branching, earlier, brighter colors, more uniform, and a couple of inches taller than Inca.

Coleus – Sun

1. Heartbreaker –

This 2020 introduction was a must have! The colors are vibrant deep pink/red and really stand out in containers and landscape. This is a full bodied plant that is extremely vibrant.

2. Colorblaze Royal Pineapple Brandy (Proven Winners)

This jazzy new Coleus for sun and shade features yellow to chartreuse luminescent foliage with accents of burgundy bronze, forming a very well-branched plant that works well in landscapes and containers. Like all ColorBlaze® Coleus, it is bred to take the heat and bloom very late in the season, if at all, extending its garden performance into the fall. Award Winner. Adaptable As Houseplant

Perennials

Hibiscus: Blackberry Merlot & French Vanilla

These North American native plants bring massive, tropical-looking flowers all the way to zone 4. Although later to emerge than most perennials in spring, these are fast growing plants capable of adding an inch of new growth a day. Excellent at brightening up end of season gardens.

Blackberry Merlot: The deepest red flowering Hardy Hibiscus we currently offer 8" rich, deep velvety red flowers are produced above a tight, upright habit of deep green leaves. A perfect centerpiece for a garden with bright and beautiful colors.



French Vanilla (Proven Winners): A breakthrough for yellow Hardy Hibiscus. Soft yellow flower buds open to 7-8" creamy custard yellow, ruffled flowers with a prominent red eye. Compared to the industry standard 'Old Yella', this Hibiscus retains its yellow color longer, has a more compact habit, has red stems and deeper green, more attractive foliage, and a very prolific floral production.

Calamint – 2021 Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year™

Common Name: Lesser Catmint

This sun-loving perennial is the perfect choice for attracting pollinators, since it blooms from early summer until frost. Tiny, white flowers cover the bushy habit. Since this is in the mint family, the leaves carry a mint scent. Perfect for rock garden enthusiasts and herb gardens. Use in the landscape as you would Nepeta (Catmint).

This could be marginally hardy as different sites list different hardiness zones.

Common Name: Columbine

The colors in this series speak for themselves. This replaces the songbird series of columbine.

Huechera Toffee Tart (Proven Winners)

Common Name: Coral Bells

'Toffee Tart' displays differing shades of ginger caramel throughout the seasons. In spring, leaves are amber to ginger with a silver overlay. In late summer, leaves mature to green. Creamy white flowers are held on burgundy stems. Perfect for brightening up landscapes or serving as a filler in combination containers.

Phlox: Rose Quartz – Creeping Phlox

These spring groundcovers take creeping Phlox to the next level of refinement and beauty. Beautifully mounded habits look better later into the spring season—you'll want to show off these beauties.

Common Name: Daylily

Characteristics

Herbs & Vegetables

Tomato - Wisconsin 55

Brought in due to demand, this tomato was developed at the University of Wisconsin and is a versatile tomato that can be used for eating or canning. This 8 oz tomato matures early.

Pepper (Hot) – Hot Burrito

This compact pepper plant produces fruit that packs heat right on your patio table or countertop! If you love hot peppers, you'll love the spicy kick of Hot Burrito. A beautiful edible pepper, it's also a gorgeous ornamental addition to containers. Its compact size makes it perfect for growing on sunny balconies, patios, porches—and even indoors in a well-lit area! Add a fully ripe Hot Burrito pepper to a bottle of your favorite oil or vinegar to infuse it with flavor. They're delicious fresh or in recipes, or add them to skewers for grilling. Peppers become hotter as they mature, with a Scoville rating of 3,000-6,000.

Pepper (Sweet) – Cherry Pick

Fruits measure 1-1/4" by 1-1/4" and are uniformly rounded and sized. Disease resistant and about 25% larger than the old strains. Yield is superb, with tall, 24", vigorous plants setting loads of sweet, dark green fruits that mature to red, although normally harvested in the green stage. Let mature totally red for excellent pickled peppers.

Basil (Genovese) – Emerald Towers (2020)

This dark green, glossy leafed, and beautiful columnar habit basil is ideal for any garden. Traditional Genovese flavor is perfect for eating fresh in caprese salad or chopped fresh in recipes. Plus, it flowers late in the season, for huge harvests of leaves throughout Summer. This plant grows upward in a columnar shape making it great for patio containers.
